<b>PURPOSE/REQUIRED ACTION:</b>		
The purpose of this agenda item is to request Council consideration of the submittal of the 2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) capital application for the Puget Sound Park Improvement Project.		
<b>BACKGROUND (Include prior Council action &amp; discussion):</b>		
In 2006, the King County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Consortium changed from a pass-through system to two subregional competitive pots. The City of Burien no longer receives an annual allocation of CDBG funds for capital projects, but now needs to apply for the competitive south sub-regional pot of funding. These CDBG funds are for capital projects that benefit low and moderate income neighborhoods. For 2011, approximately \$740,000 is available for capital projects in the south subregion. Burien plans to apply for \$150,000 in 2011 CDBG capital funding for the Puget Sound Park Improvement Project. This funding would renovate and upgrade the play equipment at this 5 acre park in the North Burien area, replace or repair picnic tables and benches, improve drainage in the play area, and add ADA accessibility. The grant application is due to King County by May 21, 2010.		
The City of Burien was previously awarded \$402,645 in 2009 - 2010 CDBG funds for the Hazel Valley Sidewalk Improvement Project.
