<p>PURPOSE/REQUIRED ACTION: The purpose of this agenda item is for Council to receive a presentation summarizing the contents of the shoreline master program (SMP) update notebooks. The notebooks contain numerous documents that provide background information on the SMP as well as the Planning Commission recommended shoreline master program updates. Formal action is not required, but direction to staff is requested.</p> <p>BACKGROUND (Include prior Council action & discussion): On March 30, 2010, the Planning Commission completed its review of a draft Shoreline Master Program (SMP) and recommended its approval to the City Council. The next phase of the adoption process is City Council review and action. Following local approval by the City Council the Department of Ecology will hold a public hearing and review the document to ensure it complies with the shoreline master program update guidelines.</p> <p>At the City Council meeting on April 5, 2010 the Council requested that a discussion on the SMP occur on May 3, 2010.
