I have lived in South Seattle since 1994 and I have volunteered for numerous tasks to support the city, county and state over these many years, and I continue to do so. I was unable to attend the public hearing for the City of Seattle Budget on Wednesday evening. I am aware that there were several citizens in attendance who urged the city to fund community centers and parks/recreation programs. A member of our community spoke about funding for the proposed replacement for the South Park Bridge. I, too, am concerned that emergency vehicles will not be able to reach the South Park neighborhood easily in an emergency if the bridge is torn down and not replaced. I urge you to work
