## RESOLUTION NO. 314

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BURIEN, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE TESTIMONY REGARDING THE PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE 2011 THROUGH 2016 SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF BURIEN

WHEREAS, State law (Ch. 35.77 RCW) requires cities to develop a six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and update it annually; and

WHEREAS, State law (RCW 35.77.010) further requires cities to conduct one or more public hearings prior to adoption of the annual six-year TIP; and

WHEREAS, in order for cities to compete for transportation funding grants from Federal and State sources most granting agencies require that projects be included in the TIP document; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Burien finds it to be in the best interests of the City to establish a date and time for a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed 2011-2016 TIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURIEN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Public Hearing. A public hearing is hereby scheduled to be held during the City Council meeting of August 2, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers located at Burien City Hall, for the purpose of taking public comments regarding the 2011-2016 Transportation Improvement Program.

Section 2. Notice of Public Hearing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the public hearing in the City's official newspaper.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Burien City Council.
